NETPDTC INSTRUCTION 11320.1

Subj: FIRE PROTECTION AND FIRE PREVENTION REGULATIONS

1. **Purpose.** To establish fire protection and fire prevention procedures in the event of fire on or adjacent to the Naval Education and Training Professional Development and Technology Center (NETPDTC) controlled buildings within the Saufley Field installation as prescribed in references (a) through (e), and to delineate responsibilities with respect to fire protection and fire safety.
2. **Cancellation.** NETPMSAINST 11320.1B
3. **Revision.** Since this is a major revision marginal notations are not annotated. This instruction should be read in its entirety.
4. **Background.** This installation is afforded fire protection by Naval Air Station, Pensacola, based on an interservice support agreement. Accordingly, it is the responsibility of the command to abide by fire regulations issued by Naval Air Station, Pensacola.
5. **Action.** Fire protection/prevention is a daily responsibility of all NETPDTC Department Heads/Special Assistants/Directors and Commanding Officer of tenant activities. The necessity of maintaining adequate fire protection safeguards is well recognized. All practical means to achieve this objective will be pursued. NETPDTC will render fire support to ensure fire protection/prevention measures are maintained in accordance with reference (b) in all areas of the activity.
